Our community recognizes the value of social visitation to connect our residents with their loved ones, friends and families. We are pleased to make visitations available, but ask that in order to keep all of our residents and co-workers safe, visitors follow our protocol and sign this acknowledgement prior to visiting. Any visitor not in compliance with our policy will be unable to continue visitations in the future. Please help to keep our community safe!

VISITATION TIMING

Visiting times are established by campus and are updated on our website at www.countrymeadows.com or www.ecumenicalretirement.org. These times may change and may not be available every day. Availability will depend on staffing, therapy appointments, and other activities.

VISITATION SCHEDULING

To schedule a time, visitors should utilize the online Schedule Genius, or contact their community by phone or email.

VISITATION PROTOCOL

- Visitation will be limited to two adult visitors and a maximum of one child visitor under the age of 12. Adult visitors must be able to manage any child in accompaniment.
- All visitors over the age of 2 and all residents **must wear masks**. Facemasks will be provided by the facility if the visitor(s) or resident cannot provide their own.
- All visitors and residents must respect social distancing, and avoid hugging or hand holding.
- All visitors must sign in prior to their visit, including sharing their name and contact information, and must sign out when they depart.
- Visitors will be screened for risk factors per the facility visitor screening tool and will be temperature checked. Any visitor who does not pass the screening will not be allowed to visit.
- Visitors must practice hand hygiene prior to visit, and hand sanitizer will be made available by the facility.
- Visitors are asked to avoid bringing personal possessions to the visit, and no items may be passed to the resident during the visit.

By signing in for a visit, you are hereby acknowledging that you have read and understood the facility protocol for visitation and agree to follow all precautions to protect the residents of Country Meadows and Ecumenical Communities.
